

TWIN PARISH PORT COMMISSION



LOCATION – The Port of Delcambre is located between New Iberia and Abbeville and is adjacent to the four lane LA. Highway 14. The Delcambre canal is approximately five miles from the Intracoastal Waterway with direct access to Vermilion Bay and SouthWest Pass. The 25-acre Port has its own access road which runs south from U.S. Highway 14 and includes a rail way which parallels the highway east to New Iberia and west to Erath and Abbeville. The Port is only eight miles from US Highway 90, which will become the future I-49 corridor. Acreage available for lease or sale by landowners is greater than 100 acres.

ORGANIZATION – The Twin Parish Port District was created by enabling legislation of Acts 1977, No. 203, § 1. Amended by Acts 1978, No. 486, § 2.

Its jurisdictional territory encompasses portions of Vermilion and Iberia Parish. The Port of Delcambre constitutes the main asset for the Twin Parish Port District. The district is governed by the Port Commission, a board of 11 commissioners appointed by the Town of Delcambre, the Town of Erath, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury, and the Iberia Parish Council. Major commercial areas within the district include the Henry hub, a national strategic natural gas distribution facility, Avery Island where the McHenry pepper factory is located, Jefferson Island, the Town of Delcambre and the Town of Erath.

PRIMARY CARGOES

Inbound – The Port of Delcambre has one of the largest shrimp processing capabilities in the country with annual transactions totaling over \$20 million. The shrimping industry is a legacy of the Port of Delcambre with private, commercial fishing vessels and trucked product entering the Port for processing and shipping nationwide.

Outbound – Processed Seafood, Fabrication projects for the oil and gas industry, modules for nuclear power plants, ice and fuel

OVERALL ANNUAL TONNAGE – Oil and Gas Fabrication – 10,000 tons; Seafood – 8,000 tons



REVENUES

The Port of Delcambre is an emerging port with Shaw fabrication as our one tenant on port property at this time. Plans have been developed and some funding received for dynamic expansion at the Port of Delcambre in tourism related activities. Industrial and commercial expansion plans have been developed with vigorous pursuit of funding underway.

TERMINALS & FACILITIES – The Port owns and operates over 2000 linear feet of dock space and 600 linear feet of bulkhead.
