

# VINTON HARBOR AND TERMINAL DISTRICT



**LOCATION** – Located on the Vinton Navigation Canal in Southwest Louisiana, the Vinton Port provides access to the Intracoastal Waterway, Interstate 10, the Sabine River, the Calcasieu River, and the Louisiana-Texas border. The District’s assets include a 815-acre tract of land, small dock, and a 20,500 SF commercial building.

**ORGANIZATION** –The Vinton Harbor and Terminal District was created by Act No. 466 of the 1956 regular session of the Louisiana Legislature. The Vinton Port is managed by a five member Board of Commissioners who serve 4-year terms.
